General Technical Information

Orchestra Pit is a screw jack pit with movement from stage level through auditorium to playing level. Pit entrance is from the basement. Pit does not move all the way to basement level, and so cannot be used to transport materials. The pit may not move with personnel on the lift.

Dimensions: Approximately 36' x 12'. Pit depth: 6' 11" (maximum depth from stage); 3' 3" (depth to seating floor).

Projection System -- The Arts Center employs a 35mm projection system with Dolby surround sound. This system is available for rental; however, only the Arts Center may select and hire a licensed projectionist. There is no provision for 16mm film projection.

Flame Retardant: The Arts Center will require hard copies of proof of flame proofing for all show equipment prior to load-in.

Special Effects -- The Arts Center will require hard copies of pyrotechnic licenses of operators, and materials information for all pyrotechnic effects. Special liability coverage relative to pyrotechnics will also be required in hard copy form. The Arts Center's Operations Manager will arrange any necessary demonstrations or examination of materials with local fire authorities.

PLEASE NOTE: Since the February 2003 Rhode Island nightclub tragedy, it is the policy of the Community Arts Center to forego all pyrotechnics unless absolutely and demonstrably essential to the nature of the production.
