Staging

Stage Floor - Tongue and groove maple of two layers of 3/4" plywood. The finish is epoxy black in a urethane base. Any attachments to the stage floor must be approved in advance by the Arts Center's Operations Manager. A Harlequin dance floor is available. This floor is reversible black/gray.

Auditorium Stairs - Stairs are available to provide access from stage to orchestra pit at seating level. These stairs may not be used otherwise due to aisle access restrictions.

Access to Stage - Stage access from the auditorium is from the orchestra pit locked at patron seating level (see Auditorium Stairs above) or through vomms located house left and right. Vom access is through the exit stair towers, then to stage, so quick access is difficult.

Dressing Rooms (described in further detail below) - Two "star" dressing rooms are accessed through downstage left, then upstage through a short hall. Two "chorus" dressing rooms are located on the second floor on the back wall of the stage, and can be accessed through either downstage right or downstage left stair towers, or by elevator located upstage right in the loading zone. Each "star" dressing room can accommodate up to four persons and each has private bath facilities. Each "chorus" dressing room can accommodate up to 24 persons; bath facilities are located at either end of the chorus dressing room corridor.

Production Office - The Arts Center has a formal production office. There are two permanent phone lines in this room: 570-327-7659 and 570-327-7660. There are two additional lines for fax machines and computers. High speed internet connections are NOT available.
